Dear Unitholder.

The Management Company Allianz Global Investors GmbH ("the Management Company") has decided, with the approval of State Street Bank International GmbH, Luxemburg Branch (the "Depositary") to implement the following changes to the fund Allianz Stiftungsfonds Nachhaltigkeit ("the fund") with effect from 10 March 2021:

Investment objective

The investment policy aims to generate appropriate regular returns while, where possible, maintaining the economic value of the assets invested. In order to generate a positive, distributable return in EUR. the Fund seeks to obtain long-term capital growth through dynamic allocation to equities and fixedincome securities and floating-rate notes, whose issuers meet the criteria of the strategy for sustainable and responsible investment as assessed by the fund management. The sustainability analysis focuses particularly on the environmental

Investment principles

- The Management Company uses an active risk-management procedure that permits it to monitor and measure at all times the risks associated with its investments and their proportion in the overall risk profile of the investment portfolio. The objectives of the investment policy are pursued on the principle of risk diversification. In general, it should be noted that the performance of the fund units is essentially determined by the price changes on each exchange trading day of the assets held in the Fund and the income.
- When selecting the assets to be acquired for the Fund, the following selection principles and exclusion criteria based on the SRI strategy are taken into account by the fund management:
 - a) The Fund invests in assets that are subject to or that meet the social, environmental, professional conduct and governance characteristics of the SRI

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policy, social policy and corporate governance pursued by the relevant issuers of equities and bonds.

- strategy. At least 90% of the Fund's portfolio has an SRI rating. In this regard, the portfolio does not include any derivatives that do not have an SRI rating or any assets that are not, by their very nature, rated as SRI (e.g. cash and deposits).
- b) The Fund does not invest in:
 - securities issued by companies that are involved in the production of tobacco;
 - securities issued by companies that are involved in the sale of tobacco products and for which this represents more than 10% of their revenues.
- c) The Fund does not invest in:
 - securities issued by companies that are involved with controversial weapons (antipersonnel mines, cluster munitions, chemical weapons, biological weapons, enriched uranium, white phosphorus and nuclear weapons);
 - securities issued by companies that generate more than 10% of their revenues from an interest in providing military equipment and corresponding services.
- d) The Fund does not invest in:
 - securities issued by companies that generate more than 10% of their revenues from the mining of thermal coal or from unconventional oil and gas production.
- e) The Fund does not invest in securities that are issued by conventional oil- and gas-producing companies that generate less than 40% of their revenues from the natural gas business
- f) The Fund does not invest in:
 - securities issued by utility companies for which
 - more than 10% of their electricity production is based on coal;
 - more than 30% of their electricity production is based on oil and gas; or
 - more than 30% of their electricity production is based on nuclear energy.
- g) The Fund does not invest in securities issued by companies that are highly controversial in terms of the principles of the United Nations Global

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Compact. If a company that is held by one of our dedicated funds for sustainable and responsible investments is involved in a serious controversy
relating to the UNGC principles, an internal process is triggered to initiate a discussion with this company. This active discussion may span
several years. If these measures are not able to achieve any changes, the Fund will divest from the positions held.

Unitholders who do not agree to these changes may redeem their units without redemption or conversion fees until 9 March 2021.
